

## FOREWORD

**B**EFORE the close of 1914, there was issued in connection with Murrayfield Church and Parish, a Roll of Honour, which, with necessary alterations, was subsequently reprinted in the Church Year Book for 1915-1916. Casualties, promotions, and other changes since then, have been of so sweeping a character, that for the purposes of the present Roll, it has been deemed advisable to make an entirely new and independent inquiry into all the available sources of information. The result, it is hoped, is, in a large measure, correct down to the end of 1917; but errors, omissions, or other imperfections and changes as they occur, will, if attention is called to them, be duly noted and retained for reference, when the conclusion of the War makes it possible to issue the Roll in what can be considered a final form. Information on all such points, or suggestions generally in regard to the undertaking will be most gratefully received.

As its title indicates, this Roll of Honour is not confined to members and adherents of Murrayfield Parish Church, but includes the names of residents within the Parish, irrespective of religious denomination. The War has done much to draw together

separate ranks and classes of the community everywhere, and it was felt that in a district like Murrayfield, tangible expression of the bond of neighbourliness would not be unwelcome. The link which unites people whose homes are side by side, is surely strong enough to make its recognition desirable. It is a link which, in point of time at any rate, if not of sentiment, is commonly more enduring than that on which School, University, and similar Rolls of Honour are based.

A place has been found in the Roll for such ex-members of the 44th Edinburgh (Murrayfield) Company, The Boys' Brigade—attached to the Parish Church—as have served in His Majesty's forces during the present crisis. The reputation of the Company has, throughout all the years of its existence, attracted recruits from far and wide. Many of these, it has not been found possible to trace; but pains have been taken to obtain the requisite information wherever available. The War has demonstrated beyond a doubt, if any existed, the inestimable value to the country of Boys' Brigade training, in respect not only of military discipline and drill, but of Christian character-building.

Rolls of Honour generally have had their origin in response to a deep-rooted instinct that the sacrifice which has at once enshrouded and enriched those gloomy, but for ever glorious, years of War, should not and must not be forgotten. The instinct is a true one, and the Roll of Honour a right and natural

expression of it. Let us trust, however, that the monument which we erect to the memory of our unreturning brave will be of a more substantial character than printed page or than the "colossal bust or column trophied for triumphal show." It is only in a revived and regenerated national life that names and deeds which have saved the Empire can be worthily perpetuated to all time.
