through Christ our Master, Amen.

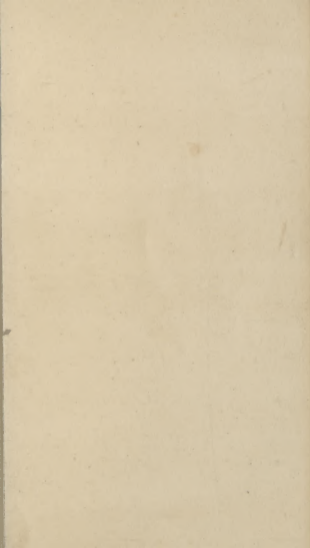
