Facal o'n Cheann-suidhe

Dìreach an am dhomh bhith cur nam faclan seo ri chèile fhuaras dearbhadh gu bheil ar cànan an déidh ceum air adhart a ghabhail. A réir Aireamhair Coitcheann na Rìoghachd chaidh còrr is 8000 a chur ri àireamh luchd-bruidhne na Gàidhlig, eadar 1961 agus 1971. Tha an naidheachd seo a' toirt mór-thoileachadh agus misneachd do na h-uile aig a bheil ùidh ann an adhartas ar cànan.

Bhon am seo 'n uiridh rinneadh sgioblachadh mór air riaghailtean agus dòighean obrach a' Chomuinn. Tha a nise An Comunn ag oibreachadh fo chomhairlean-riaghlaidh a bhios a' coinneachadh gach dara mìos, no mar a bhios feum orra. Chan eil Comhairle Choitcheann a' Chomuinn, an cumantas, a' coinneachadh ach dà uair sa' bhliadhna. Tha seo gun teagamh a' dèanamh ar saothrach nas éifeachdaiche agus nas lugha cosgais.

Tha ceithir Roinnean a' Chomuinn a' dèanamh gu math agus tha sinn gu h-àraidh a' cur fàilte air an Roinn ùir a chaidh a stéidheachadh an Earraghaidheal. Tha i seo an déidh deagh adhartas a dhèanamh anns na beagan mhìosan on a chuireadh air bonn i. Bu mhath leinn — nan robh an t-airgead againn — oifis ùr fhosgladh anns na h-Eileanan Siar, far a bheil Coinneach MacIomhair a' cumail ghnòthaichean a' dol mar Iar Fhear-stiùiridh a' Chomuinn. Ach tha an t-airgead fhathast gann agus tha e doirbh dhuinn ar rùintean uile a thoirt gu buil mar bu mhiann leinn.

A dh'aindeoin gun deachaidh Taghadh Pàrlamaid a stobadh a staigh 'na mheadhon, bha Mòd air leth soirbheachail againn an Dun-dèagh agus tha làn aobhar againn air taing mhór chridheil a thoirt do Chomhairle Ionadail Dhun-dèagh airson na h-obrach ionmholta a rinn iad ann an suidheachadh a bha uaireannan glé mhi-ghealltanach. Mur b'e an t-airgead a tha An Comunn a' faighinn o na Mòdan Nàiseanta bha e air a dhol fodha o chionn fada.

Tha An Comunn a nise a' toirt barrachd aire do dh'obair an Dràma na b' àbhaist dhaibh agus tha adhartas anns an raoin fheumail seo cuideachd. Bha mòran a bharrachd sluaigh aig co-fharpais an Dràma an Dun-dèagh na chunnacas aig gin de na co-fharpaisean Dràma aig na Mòdan Nàiseanta roimhe seo.

Tha sinn fhathast a' gearan air craobh-sgaoileadh — agus tha aobhar againn. Tha sinn toilichte gun deachaidh An Comunn an co-bhuinn ris a' Chomunn Oiseanach anns an taisbeanadh-diomb a chaidh a chur an céill an Glaschu o chionn ghoirid agus tha sinn an dòchas gun dean e feum. Tha mi-fhìn a' smaoinichadh gun dèan.

Mar ann am bliadhnanachan eile, bha sgoilean Ghàidhlig na bliadhna chaidh seachad soirbheachail agus feumail. Tha mór-fheum a nise air clasaichean còmhraidh air feadh na dùthcha agus tha 'n t-am air tighinn anns a bu chòir do luchd-ionnsachaidh a bhith a' gabhail pàirt ann an

dràma. An àite bhith ri goralais mu, “Cò aige tha Ghàidhlig as fheàrr?” tha’n t-am aig cuid againn fàs suas! Ma tha sinn fileanta ann an cànan sam bith, chan eil e gu diubhar cuin a dh’fhàs sinn fileanta — aig cóig bliadhna, no cóig bliadhna fichead, no aig aois sam bith eile. An diugh, tha luchd-ionnsachaidh na Gàidhlig ’nan taic mhóir do ar n-aobhar. Bitheamaid toilichte gu bheil iad còmhla rinn agus bitheamaid gam misneachadh ’s gan cuideachadh.

Air a’ bhliadhna chaidh seachad, chaidh iomadh beàrn a dhèanamh air ballachan A’ Chomuinn Ghaidhealaich. Aig an am seo tha sinn a’ cuimhneachadh gu h-àraidh air ar caraid còir, an t-Urramach Iain MacDhùghaill, a bha ’na Iar Cheann-suidhe air a’ Chomunn. Tha sinn ga ionndrain ’s ga chaoidh.

Bu mhath leam taing dhùrachdach a thoirt do na h-uile airson mar a chuidich iad leam ré mo réis mar Cheann-suidhe a’ Chomuinn. Dh’iarrainn cuideachd taing mhór a thoirt do Bhuill-beatha a’ Chomuinn airson mo litir a fhreagairt le còrr math is mìle not a chur ri airgead a’ Chomuinn. Mórán taing dhuibh uile gu léir.

Suil air ais air a' Bhliadhna

An iomadach dòigh rinneadh adhartas mòr am bliadhna. Aig a' Choinneimh Bhliadhnail ann an Dun-dèagh ghabh na buill ri atharraich chudthromach ann am Bonn-stéidh A' Chomuinn, atharraich a rinn e fada na b'fhasa dhuinn ar n-obair a chur air adhart gu h-éifeachdach. 'Se bliadhna shoirbheachail cuideachd a bha gu h-àraid aig an Roinn as ùire de'n Chomunn — Earraghaidheal. Chaidh meuran ùra stéidheachadh an sin, mar a chaidh cuideachd ann an Roinn a' Chinn-a-tuath, agus chuir Comhairle na Roinne air bhonn céilidh mhór ann an caisteal Inbhiraora, a bha air leth math.

Bha dà sgoil-shamhraidh againn — ann an Steòrnabhagh agus ann an Sléibhte, agus rinn iad le chéile feum mòr. Bhatar a' deasachadh cuideachd cùrsa-phuist, a bhios a' tighinn gu buil ann an 1975. Chum sinn oirnn a' cur a mach leabhraichean — ceithir ann an 1974 còmhla ri dà leabhran-fiosrachaidh, agus thòisich sinn ri cuairtlitrichean a chur chun nam meuran, los gum bi eòlas na's soilleiriche aca air an obair a tha sinn a' deanamh. Chuir sinn seachad ùine mhór a' déiligeadh ris a' chraobh-sgaoileadh, eadar Comhairle MhicCreamhain, nach robh uabhasach fàbharach do'n Ghàidhlig, agus Comhairle Annain, a dh'fheumas a bhith na's fheàrr.

Ré na bliadhna bha obair mhór aig an luchd-tuarasdail. Chuir Iain Murchadh Moireasdan dheth a dhreuchd mar Iar-fhear-stiùiridh, agus chuir sinn fàilte air Coinneach MacIomhair a tha a nis ag obair gu trang anns na h-eileanan. Thadhal an Comhòrdanaiche air meuran air feadh na dùthcha agus chuidich e gu mòr le stéidheachadh nam meuran ùra. Mar as àbhaist bha gnothach mòr aig an Leas-fhear-stiùiridh ris a' Mhòd Nàiseanta, a bha air leth soirbheachail am bliadhna ann an Dun-dèagh, agus bha am Fear-stiùiridh fhéin air falbh bho'n tigh gu math tric eadar coinneamhan nan comhairlean agus coinneamhan ri luchd an fhoghlaim, ri luchd a' chraobh-sgaoilidh etc.

A chionn 's gu bheil riaghailtean ùra aig A' Chomunn a thaobh cìsean nam ball — gum bi a' chuid as motha de na coisirean a nis a' pàigheadh cìs air leth an àite a bhith 'nam buill de'n Chomunn, agus nach bi An Comunn a' faighinn cìsean buill nam meuran tuilleadh — tha e doirbh àireamh nam ball a chunntadh. Ach tha na figearan a leanas a' toirt dealbh air choir-eiginn air a' chùis:
