IT is now an established maxim with regard to education, that, in its earliest stages, it should be rendered as inviting as possible. Instruction gains admission most readily into the minds of children, when it comes to them in the guise of amusement; but it is of importance that this amusement be not merely alluring, but essentially conducive to their improvement. most pleasing, because it is not, as in puzzles, too great, and is seldom exert ed in vain. The degree of attention too, which these characters require tends to imprint on the mind the instruction conveyed under them, more deeply than could be done by any other method.

It would be idle to dwell on the utility of familiarizing, by this method, to the tender mind, the interesting narrations and the important truths contained in the Sacred Scriptures; yet it may not be superfluous to remark, that no species of composition is more susceptible than the Scriptures of hieroglyphic imagery. The narrative parts are so graphic as almost to paint to the senses the scenes which they describe; and even in the didactic parts, there is a beautiful simplicity and accommodation to the notions and habits of men, which render them extremely well adapted to ensible representation.
