That if any Alarum be in the night time; that then, all the Inhabitants of the laid Citie and Liberties, shall forthwith hang out lights, at the doores of their severall Houses.

That none of the Officers belonging to the Trained Bands, doe lodge out of the

Citie; dureing these times of imminent Danger.

That upon any generall Alarum by night or day, the Collonels, other Field Officers and Captains, with the severall companies of the Trained Bands of the said Citie, (compleatly Armed and well surnified with Ammunition) are forthwith to repaire to their severall Alarum places, herein after mentioned, and there to attend, untill they shall receive further order.
