

CAn acte that purveyors shall not take victualles, Within syue myles of
Cambydge and Oxforde.



Umblly sue to your Maiesties, the societees, Colleges, & compaines, of your true and faythfull subiectes, & daylye oratours the scholers & studentes of both youre maiesties vniuersities, Cambydge and Oxforde, that where it hath bene accustomed tym out of mynde that both the sayd market townes of Cambridge and Oxford, wherin the sayd two vniuersities, be set, and the circuite of syue myles next adioyning, hath ben fre from anye charge or molestation of anye common takers, or purveyors for victual, wherby the sayd markettes, were more plentifully serued w^t victuall, and the poore estate of a great multytude of schollers, hauyng verye bare and small sustentation thereby releued, and nowe by the meanes that contrary to þ same laudable custome, diuerse purveyors, and takers haue of late excessyuely frequented the sayd marketes, and thereby giuen occasion to make the victelles both more skant and much derer, to a notorious decaye of schollers, which also dayly in this great derth, is lyk^r to encresse and be moze lamentable, to the hinderance of god^s seruyce, the dishonor of the realme, the discomforde of all good and holy men, louyng learnyng and vertue. It may therefore please your maiesties of your great ptye and abundant fauor and loue towardes your sayd two vniuersities, beyng the verye two onely nyses of good learnyng in this realme, with the assent of the Lordes spirituall & temporall, and the commons, in this present parliament assembled, and by the auctoritie of the same, to enacte, ordene and establishe, that fromhenceforth no maner of purveyors, taker bager, looder, or other minister, maye or shall take or bargayne for anye kynde of victuall or grayne, in any of the sayd markettes or townes of Cambydge, and the Citie of Oxforde, nor shall take or bargayne for any victuall, within the compasse of syue myles, therto adioynyng, without the consent agreement or good wyll of the owner or owners, nether shall attempte to cary take awaie, or bargayne for any maner of grayne, or other victuall, bought or prouyded within the sayd space of syue myles by any commone mynster, of anye Colledge, hostell, or hall to be spent within any of the sayd Colledges, hostelles, or halles, vpon payne of the forfeyture of the quadruple value, of any such maner grayne, or byctuall so taken or bargayned for, in any of the sayd markettes, or within the sayd space of syue myles, agaynst the wil of þ owners, as is abovesayd, or attempted to be taken caryed awaie, or bargayned for, beinge prouyded as is abovesayd, for to be spent in any the Colledges, hostels, or halles, And further shal suffer imprysoment, for the space of three Moneths, withoute bayle or maynepryse, and that the Chauncellour, or vicechauncelloz, or his Commyssary for the tyme beyng, in eyther of the sayd vniuersities, with two Justices of peace, of the Countie, wherein the sayd vniuersities be sette, shall haue full power by auctorite of thys acte, to enquyre by the othes of .xiij. men of and vpon the defaultes and offences commytted contrary to the tenor thereof, and to see due punyshment and reformation thereof in forme aforesayde from tyme to tyme, the one halfe of whych forsayd forfeytures to be to the common treasure of eyther the sayd vniuersities respectyuely to the faulte, commytted, agaynst this their priuiledge, the other halfe to þ partye that wyll sue for the same, by action of debte, byl, playnt, or otherwyse in any courte of record, or before the forsayd Chauncellour, his vice chauncelloure, or comyssary for the tyme

being, and two justices of peace as is before expressed.

Provyded that this acte shall not be put in execution at anye tyme or tymes when soever your maisties or the heyyes or successours of your maiestie our soueraigne Ladye, shall please to come to any of both the sayd vniuersities or within seauen myles of eyther of thē, but shal be in suspence duryng that tyme onely and not longer.

Provided alwayes and be it enacted by thauitorie aforesayd, that this acte or any thing therein conteyned shall not in any wyse be prejudicall or hurtfull to the Mayre Baylyffe, & Comminaltie of the Citie of Oxford, nor to the Mayre and Comminaltie of the Towne of Cambrydge, or to their Successours, for and concerningyng any of their liberties or pruileges, but that they and every of them, and their succelours respectyvly may haue and vse þ same in such maner & form, as they or anyz of thē, might or ought to haue done before the makynge of thyss acte, any thing in this acte conteyned to the contrarye notwithstanding.
