

ADVERTISEMENT

By Order of the Justices of the Peace of the County of Aberdeen, met at their adjourn'd Quarter Sessions upon the twenty second Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and fifty seven Years.

HE faids Justices do hereby appoint and ordain all Persons within this County, to thresh out all the Grain in the Country, and make the same into Meal betwixt and the first Tuesday of August next, with certification that if any shall be found thereafter in Barns or Yards, the same will be confiscate to the Poor, and the Proprietors thereof will be punished as Forestallers and Regrators; and that every Person having more Meal than will serve his own Family till the next Cropt, do carry the Superplus to the next Market-Towns, there to be fold at the current Prices: And the Justices do hereby certify that they are determined to make strict Enquiry into this Affair, and to know how far this Resolution is observed or transgressed, fo as all Offenders may be brought to condign Punishment; and appoints this Advertisement and Resolution to be printed and published at the whole Parish-Kirks within this County, by the Precentors from their Latrons, immediately after divine Service in the Forenoon, upon the first Sunday after Receipt hereof. Signed by Order and Appointment of the Meeting by Sir James Reid of Barra, Baronet, Præses to the Meeting.
