And hath been, in due Form of Law in the Confistory Court of the Bisshop of London, Convicted of the Sin of Adultery with one Mr. Saunders, upon Full and Undeniable Evidence; and hath broke the Marriage-Vow on her Part. likely that there should be any other than Spurious Islue by the faid Sarah, that may fucceed him in his and his Father's Estate unless the faid Marriage be Dissolved, and declared Void, and Annulled by the Authority of Parliament; and the faid Francis Loggin be enabled to Intermarry with any other Woman. May it please Your most Excellent Majesty, out of Your Princely Goodness and Compassion to Your Petitioner the faid Francis Loggin's Misfortune and Calamity, and for the future Support and Comfort of himself and Family, That it may be Enacted, and it is accordingly hereby Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, By and With the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and of the Commons in this present Parliament Assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the said Bond of Matrimony being Broken and Violated by the manifest Open Adultery of the faid Sarah Gardner, The faid Marriage be and is hereby Enacted, Declared, and Adjudged to be from henceforth wholly Diffolved, Annulled, Vacated, and made Void to all Intents, Conftructions, and Purpofes whatfoever. And that it shall and may be Lawful to and for the faid Francis Loggin at any Time or Times hereafter to Contract Matrimony, and to Marry in the Life-Time of the faid Sarah Gardner, as if the was naturally Dead, with any other Woman with whom he might Lawfully Marry in Cafe the faid Sarah were not Living: And that fuch Matrimony Had and Celebrated, shall be a Good, Just, and Lawful Marriage, and so shall be Adjudged, Deemed, and Taken to all Intents, Gonstructions, and Purposes.
