 the same. Whereunto is added the true Relation of the whole number of all that haue  
 dyed of this Visitation, from the 17. of December, 1602. to the 13. of this present moneth of  
 October. 1603. with the whole number of all that haue dyed in Westminster,  
 in the Sauoy, in Stepney, Newington, and sundry other places,  
 since the sicknesse beganne there.

From the first great plague in our memory after the losse of New-  
 hauen, from the first of January, 1562. to December, 1563. there  
 dyed of the Plague, twenty thousand, one hundred, thirty, six.  
 And in the last Visitation, from the 20. of December, 1592, to  
 the 23. of the same moneth in the yeare 1593. dyed in all, 25886. of  
 the Plague in and about London, 15003. And in the yeare before, 2000.  
 And now in this present Visitation which it pleaseth God to strike us with,  
 there hath dyed from the 17. of December, 1602. to the 14. of July, 1603. the  
 whole number in London and the Liberties, 4314. Whereof, of the Plague,  
 3310. The rest are set down, as they haue followed weekly.
