the Plague in and about London, 15003. And in the year before, 2000.

And now in this present Visitation which it pleaseth God to strike vs with,
there hath dyed from the 17. of December, 1602, to the 14. of July, 1603, the
whole number in London and the Liberties, 4314. Whereof, of the Plague,
