Own Choice Music

- All own choice pieces must be submitted by 31 July with the exception of all Final Competitions i.e. Comps. Nos. GS224, TS232, SS254, which are to be submitted when qualification is obtained.
- With the exception of the Traditional Song and the M. Kennedy Fraser competitions (see below), 2 copies of words and music for each song plus translation must be submitted.
- Each copy must be marked with the competitor's name and competition number.
- Each copy must be clearly marked with the competitor's name and competition number.

Traditional Song (Comps. Nos. A230 and A231)

- 2 copies of the words only must be supplied.
- Each copy must be clearly marked with the competitor's name and competition number.

M Kennedy Fraser (Comp. No. A270)

- 3 copies of the words and music plus translation must be supplied
- Each copy must be clearly marked with the competitor's name and number.

Entries will not be accepted if the correct number of, and properly marked, copies are not received by 31 July.

Trophies

All trophies must be returned to An Communn's office by 30 June to enable engraving and other preparation work for the forthcoming Mod to be carried out. Failure to comply with this instruction will result in the levying of a £10 administration fee for each 30 day overdue period (or part thereof).

Senior Choral

- Ladies and Male Voice Choirs must consist of a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 26 voices.
- Mixed Choirs must consist of a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 30 voices.
- Conductors must not sing with their choirs.
- Prescribed pieces may be sung, if necessary, a semi-tone higher or lower than the set key.
- Choirs competing in the Lovat and Tullibardine Shield and the Lorn Shield competitions must consist of at least 25% Gaelic speakers, i.e. Gold Card holders.
- Choirs competing in the Margrat Duncan Memorial Trophy competition must consist of at least 20% Gaelic speakers, i.e. Gold Card holders.
- All choirs must learn "Sus Leis a' Ghàidhlig" and "Oldhche Mhath Leibh" and the first verse of Psalm 65, to the tune "French".

Senior Solo

- Competitors are limited to the performance of a maximum of 28 lines, including chorus.
- Prescribed pieces should be sung in a key to suit the voice.

Folk Groups

- Groups must consist of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 6 players and may use electronic music. The group is responsible for providing their own PA system.
- A competitor may not play in two groups in the same competition.

Duets and Quartets

- A competitor may not sing in two groups in the same competition.

Junior Choral

- Chords must consist of a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 26 voices.
- A competitor may not sing in two choirs in the same competition.
- Competitors cannot compete in a Senior Choir at the same Mod.
- Prescribed pieces may be sung, if necessary, a semi-tone higher or lower than the set key.
- Conductors must not sing with their choirs.
- All choirs must learn "Sus Leis a' Ghaidhlig" and "Oidhe Mhath Leith".

Concerts

- First prizewinners of all competitions must appear, if required to do so, at the Evening Concert. They must report to the marshalling area backstage by 7.15pm on the evening.

Literary Competitions

- Pen names must be supplied and marked on each page of the entry. Each entry must be accompanied by a separate entry form.
- All work must be typewritten or computer printer produced. Any handwritten entries from juniors must be accompanied by a signed letter from their teacher or parent indicating that a computer or typewriter is not available.

Instrumental Competitions

- Competitors may refer to music during performance.
- A competitor may not play in two groups in the same competition.
- Fiddle groups must consist of a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 7 players, choosing from the following instruments: Fiddle, viola or cello, double bass, piano, accordion or melodeon.
- Piping competitors should refer to the Piping Convener for rule details.

Age limit

- Competitors in the Junior Section must be within the prescribed age group on the first day of October of the year in which the Mod is held.

Competitions

- Competitors are balloted by HQ and listed in the Mod Programme. Competitors should appear in the order balloted. If they are delayed at another competition or venue they must advise the Chief Steward who will relay this information to the competition venue affected. Every effort must be made to adhere to the order of ballot.
- A competition will be closed by the Chairperson as soon as all competitors have had fair opportunity to appear. The Chairperson's decision in closure of a competition is final.
- No competitor may sing or play, as their own choice, any piece prescribed for the current Mod.
- No competitor may sing the same song twice in one year.
- The Gold Medal, the Traditional Gold Medal, the Oban Times Gold Medal and the Silver Pendant can only be won once. All other competitions, with the exception of quartets, duets and choirs, can be won for two successive years only.
- All efforts will be made to avoid ties in competitions. In the event of a tie the higher Gaelic mark will be used to determine places.

Adjudication

- Adjudication sheets will be available from a designated collection point approx. 4 hours after the end of the competition. Full details will be advised at each Mod. Any adjudication sheets not collected will be posted.
- Adjudicators may, at any time, call upon a competitor to cease performing and leave the stage.
- Adjudicators may withhold prizes.
- Adjudicators' decisions are final.

Rules and Gaelic Assessment Guidelines

- It is imperative that all competitors read and adhere to the following rules.
- Failure to supply all information and correct copies of music and words may lead to disqualification from the competition.
- Permission must be obtained prior to photocopying of any sheet music which is copyright of An Comunn
- No accompanist is allowed except in the Kennedy-Fraser competition.
- An Comunn Gaidhealach reserves the right to refuse any entry.

• Entries

- All entries must be on official entry forms and received by An Comunn Gaidhealach, 109 Church Street, Inverness by 31 May.
- Any entries received on other paper or in any other form will not be accepted. If photocopies of official entry forms are used the copy colour must be as the original.
- No faxed, late or entries without the correct entry fee will be accepted.
- Competitors in the Senior Section must be paid up members of An Comunn Gaidhealach.
- Senior Choirs and Groups must pay an affiliation fee as stated on the current entry form.
- Competitors and Choir Conductors must not consult words or music whilst competing, except in instrumental competitions.
- First prizewinners from Provincial Mods can enter competitions after the closing date. The Local Mod Secretary is responsible for entering the winner within one week of the Provincial Mod.
