





Rules of Bunker Golf.



WITH REVOLVING CENTRE

Bunker Golf.



THIS game can be played by any number of players, as in ordinary golf, either as a hole or stroke game. It also affords excellent scope for the practice of "Putting" by the individual.

It is acknowledged to be not only a scientific but an amusing and patiencetrying game combined.

As a Parlour and Lawn Game "Bunker Golf" ranks among the best, being suitable for old and young, and appealing to all by its sporting and competitive possibilities.

As a nearer approach to a complete Golf Course, the distribution of several Bunkers with varied centres and an equal number of Teeing Grounds on any lawn or suitable space will be found to greatly increase the capabilities of the game, making it more interesting and fascinating.

Rules for Bunker Golf.

r.—The Bunker shall be placed in the centre of the room or lawn, or any other suitable place for a Golf Course in miniature. The Tee shall be placed at a distance of (for house play) 8 ft. from the Bunker in any direction, and shall not be moved during the progress of any game and shall be the starting point for every hole played. (Any longer distance for the lawn, but not less than 8 ft.)

2.—The Players shall always play in rotation, any player playing out of turn shall forfeit two strokes.

In a Hole Game the object of the players shall be to hole out in the least number of strokes, the player doing so shall have won that hole. All other holes to be played in a like manner.

4.—In the Stroke Game all strokes must be counted. The player holing out in the fewest strokes in the stipulated course shall be the winner.

- 5.—"Holing out" consists in playing the ball straight through any channel. Any ball deviating at Mid-Channel shall not be counted holed out, but shall count in ordinary play. Any ball shall not be counted holed out unless quite clear of the Bunker.
- 6.—After a hole has been gained all Players must start again from the Teeing Ground.
- 7.—A full game shall consist of nine holes or 18 for the double round, but by arrangement more or less may be agreed upon before starting any game.
- 8.—Before commencing a game the player who plays last, shall spin the revolving centre; after the centre shall be at rest it must not be altered again during each hole played, except by such movement as shall occur in the course of play by contact with the Ball only.
- 9.—A Ball becoming unplayable may, by forfeiting one stroke, be placed one foot clear of any obstacle.

ro.—A Ball stopping on the revolving disc must remain until other players have had their turn. In the event of another player knocking the said Ball through, it shall count as being holed out. Any Ball being displaced by another Ball in course of Play must be replaced in its original position.

II.—In the event of a "Tie" between any Players, the hole shall be counted half-point to the said players.

12.—The Strokes, either in a hole or stroke game, shall be limited to ten to each hole, should all the players reach this limit, the hole shall be considered "played."
