And Exhibition snobs.

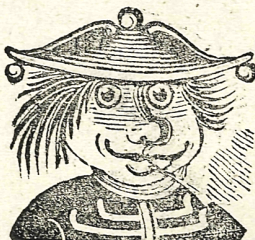
So everything we do behold
