LAW RESPECTING CARRIAGE,

Shewing how far Carriers are responsible.

There is always an implied contract in law, on the part of every Carrier or Barge-master, to be answerable for the goods he carries, unless the goods are

consumed or damaged by the act of God, as by lightning, a sudden gust of wind, &c.

If a man delivers goods to a Common Carrier, to carry to a certain place, and he loses them, an action upon the case lies against him; for by the custom of the realm, he ought to carry them safely. And if he be a Common Carrier, though there be no agreement or rate settled, or promised of payment, yet he may recover his hire, on a *quantum meruit*, and therefore shall be liable for loss and damages.

It is clearly resolved, that if a Carrier be *robbed*, he shall answer for the value of the goods; for he has his hire, which implies an undertaking for the safe custody and delivery of them, which charges him at all events: and this political institution was introduced, the better to secure people in their dealings, and to prevent Carriers, who are often entrusted with things of the greatest value, from confederating with robbers, &c.]

A Carrier is not accountable for cash, or other valuable articles, unless delivered to him as such, and paid for at an advanced rate. The true principle of a Carrier's being answerable is the reward; and a higher price ought in conscience to be paid him for the insurance of money, and other valuable things, than for insuring common goods of little value. He may make a special contract, or he may refuse to contract, in extraordinary cases, unless on extraordinary terms.

Carriers are accountable in case of fire, as determined in M. 25 G. 3.

LAW RESPECTING CARRIAGE.

If a Carrier has goods *stolen* from him, he may prefer an indictment against the felon, as for his own goods; for though he has not the actual property, yet he has such a possessory property, that he may maintain an action of trespass against any one who takes them from him, and may therefore indict a thief for taking them. The indictment would also have been good, had it been brought by the real owner.

A Carrier shall not evade the law, by refusing to carry goods at the prices limited: for if a Common Carrier, who is offered his hire, and has convenience, refuses to carry goods, he is liable to an action, in the same manner as an inn-keeper who refuses to entertain a guest, or a smith who refuses to shoe a horse.

A Carrier may refuse to admit goods into his warehouse at an unseasonable time, or before he is ready to take his journey: but he cannot refuse to do the duty incumbent upon him, by virtue of his public employment.

A delivery of goods to the Carrier's servant, is a delivery to the Carrier; and if they are delivered to a Carrier's porter, and lost, an action will lie against the Carrier.

A Carrier may refuse to deliver goods without being paid his hire. And if the goods are stolen, the right owner shall not have them without paying for the carriage; for as the Carrier is obliged to receive and carry them, the law will not deprive him of the remedy for the reward due for the carriage.

REGULATIONS OF PORTERS,

As fixed by the Magistrates of Glasgow, 27th Dec. 1792.

By an Act of the Magistrates and Town Council of Glasgow, no Porter shall refuse employment, when he is not otherwise engaged, under the penalty of 2s. 6d. sterling for the first offence, 5s. for the second, and 10s. for every subsequent offence; and all Porters who say they are engaged, shall specify the person by whom, and the hour at which, they are engaged, and they shall not refuse to be employed in the interval, between the time they are required to serve and the hour of their engagement, under the penalties aforesaid. As the Porters who wear badges on their breast, find security for their honesty and fidelity, the Magistrates recommend it to the inhabitants to employ only those Porters in matters of importance. The following is a Table of their Fees:

In all cases Carters are to load and unload such articles on their
 Carts as they are capable of doing; and, in other instances, they shall
 assist in loading and unloading their Carts.

All such quantities as are to be considered as a single Cart load, and
 likewise all rates of fares, not before specially provided for, in case
 of any dispute concerning these between the Carter and his employer,
 shall be settled by the fitting Magistrate, observing in all such cases
 as nearly as may be, the spirit and analogy of the foregoing Regu-
 lations.

No Carters, or servants of Carters, shall exact higher fares than
 those before specified, under the penalty of five shillings for each of-
 fence, to be levied by a summary warrant from any of the Magistrates
 of Glasgow, and by imprisonment till payment of the fines be made,
 besides forfeiting the fares overcharged.
